## **ORDER**

Kenyatta Nyirenda, J.

The Applicant instituted the present case by way of originating summons, dated 10<sup>th</sup> March 2016, by which summons it sought several declarations and orders. The Applicant also sought and was granted an interim order of injunction.

Hearing of the case was concluded on 20<sup>th</sup> April 2016 and, following a specific request by Counsel Nyambo that the Applicant be allowed to file written submissions, the Court ordered both parties to prepare and file with the Court their respective final written submissions within 14 days of 20<sup>th</sup> April 2016.

The Respondent filed with the Court its submissions on 17<sup>th</sup> May 2016. Despite more than two months having elapsed since the deadline set by the Court, the Applicant has yet to file its final written submissions.



In the absence of written submissions by the Applicant, the action is dismissed for failure to comply with directions. As the action has been dismissed, the interim order of injunction cannot stand. In the premises, I also discharge the interim order of injunction.
