WATERWORKS (SOUTHERN REGION WATER BOARD)

(AMENDMENT) BY-LAWS, 2018

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 56 of the Waterworks Act, the Southern Region Water Board, with the approval of the Minister of Agriculture, Irrigation and Water Development, make the following By-laws—

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Waterworks (Southern Region Water Board) (Amendment) By-laws, 2018. Citation
2. The Waterworks (Southern Region Water Board) By-laws (hereinafter referred to as the "principal By-laws") are amended, in by-law 2, by inserting, immediately after the definition of the expression "temporary purpose", the following definition—
"temporary water connexion" means a water connexion temporarily made for a period not exceeding one year for purposes of building, construction or other temporary activity;" Amendment of by-law 2 to Cap. 72:01 Sub. leg. p. 25
3. The principal By-laws are amended, in by-law 96, by inserting, immediately after paragraph (7), the following paragraphs as paragraphs (8), (9) and (10) in correct numerical sequence—
" (8) The Board shall include "industrial customer" as an additional customer category that shall be charged appropriately. Insertion of new paragraphs (8), (9) and (10) into by-law 96
 (9) Each water connection made by the Board shall always have a non-return valve.
 (10) The Board shall have different water deposit fee for a temporary connection that may be used to cover cost in the event that a customer has defaulted."
4. The principal By-laws are amended, immediately after by-law 108, by inserting a new by-law 108A as follows—
"By-laws Section 108A. The Board may, at any time, maintain a section to be known as the "By-laws Section" in any of its supply areas or centres which will be mandated to implement the provisions of these By-laws, among other functions". Insertion of new by-law 108A
5. The principal By-laws are amended, in by-law 115 paragraph (4)(b), by deleting the words "K5,000" and substituting therefor the words "a charge of cost of replacement using prevailing market price". Amendment of by-law 115

(a) inserting, immediately after the By-law designation "99", a paragraph designation "(1)"; and

(b) inserting, immediately after the By-law, the following new paragraph as paragraph (2)—

"(2) For each water connection, a water meter shall be fitted at least one metre within a customer's premises.
