AGRICULTURE (GENERAL PURPOSES) ACT

(CAP. 65:05)

AGRICULTURE (GENERAL PURPOSES) (MINIMUM PRICES FOR
AGRICULTURAL CROPS) REGULATIONS, 2020

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 2 (3) of the Agriculture (General Purposes) Act, I, FRANCIS KASAILA, Minister of Agriculture and Food Security, make the following Regulations—

- Citation 1. The Regulations may be cited as the Agriculture (General Purposes) (Minimum Prices for Agricultural Crops) Regulations, 2020.
- Minimum prices for agricultural crops GN 14/2008 2. A person with a valid licence under the Agriculture produce (Marketing) Regulations, who buys or intends to buy the Agricultural crops listed in the Schedule hereto shall pay the minimum prices as set out therein.
- Prices applicable 2019/20 growing season 3. The prices shall be applicable for the 2019/20 growing season.
- Revocation of licence for violation of regulations 4. A person who buys any of the agricultural crops below the prescribed minimum price commits an offence and the Minister shall revoke the licence.
