

lost their lives growing up into mature and educated persons they would have provided the two plaintiffs with some financial help. There were real prospects of dependency in future which were lost when the infants lost their lives. The first plaintiff described the infants as his gifts from God and as such were a source of comfort and satisfaction to the two plaintiffs. There are no figures to go by. I would award a lump sum of K12,000 to the plaintiffs plus costs of these proceedings.
