### ELECTORAL COMMISSION

#### BY-ELECTION ORDER

In the matter of section 23 (1) of the Presidential, Parliamentary and Local Government Elections Act, 2023

Whereas, the Local Government Council seats for Mwasa Ward in Mangochi Central Constituency and Mtiya Ward in Zomba Central Constituency became vacant pursuant to section 23 (1) of the Presidential, Parliamentary and Local Government Elections Act, 2023 due to the death of these as below—

Now, the Malawi Electoral Commission hereby issues an order declaring that—

1. By-elections for the Local Government Council seats for Mwasa Ward in Mangochi North-East and Mtiya Ward in Zomba Central Constituency shall be held on Tuesday, 26th September, 2023 in accordance with the Presidential, Parliamentary and Local Government Elections Act, 2023 from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m.

2. Registration of voters shall be conducted from 20th August to 26th August 2023 at all Registration Centres from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on all the registration days; and:

3. The receipt of the nominations of candidates, in respect of each of the wards shall take place on 12th September 2023 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the following venues—

4. Upon receipt of this Order, the Returning Officers for the respective wards should proceed to hold the by-elections in the manner prescribed by the Presidential, Parliamentary and Local Government Act, 2023.
