## JUDGMENT

The Court will deliver its full judgment in Chambers. It is the finding of this Court upon a careful reading of the lower court record and having listened to the submissions in Open Court on behalf of the appellant as well as the State, the conviction cannot be supported. The money paid by the appellant as compensation according to the sentence imposed by the Magistrate should be paid back to him.
