UPON READING the Sworn Statements in support of the applications for permission to apply for judicial review and for an interlocutory order of injunction made by **ESTHER KATHUMBA**, MONICA CHANG'ANAMUNO, KEZZIE MSUKWA, GIFT TRAPENCE and MOSES **MKANDAWIRE**;

AND UPON HEARING Counsel on behalf of (he above named Applicants for Permission to apply for Judicial Review and for an interlocutory order of injunction in respect of the I"4 Respondent s promulgation of Public Health (Corona Virus Prevention, Containment and Management) Rules. 2020 and the decision to declare and enforce a lockdown made by the Respondents;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DIRECTED by the Court:

- THAT the application for permission to apply for Judicial Review be granted as prayed for;
